Apprenticeship Program

Each year, TransGrid offers apprenticeships in the areas of Electrical and Transmission Lines at various locations throughout NSW. The type of apprenticeship and location varies from year to year depending on the needs of the business.

These apprenticeships involve a four year training contract administered by the Department of Education and Training which incorporates 'on the job' training as well as paid leave to attend 'off the job' learning.
